Campbell, Kristin – **PROBATION** – Originally obtained her education while incarcerated, her dental hygienist license is revoked, felony dealing and manufacturing in meth, felony battery while incarcerated, felony theft still owes fine \$183 and \$168 cannot determine if she is on probation after being released from prison

Payne, Myia – **PROBATION** – Currently incarcerated, felony dealing in cocaine, felony dealing in meth., felony neglect of dependents

Wyatt, Lindsey(online) – **PROBATION** – Currently incarcerated, felony charge of robbery resulting in serious bodily injury

Pham, Vy Thi Khanh (online) – **DENIED** – License was originally obtained in Pennsylvania in 2007. Also license in Missouri, that license has had disciplinary action taken on it, falsified question 3 on the application.

Nguyen, Quoc Anh (online) – **DENIED** – License was obtained in Vietnam, education provided does not meet Indiana's education requirements.

Redding, Duane – **PROBATION** – Incarcerated 2001 felony possession of cocaine, 2003 felony child molestation

Green, Isiah – **PROBATION** – 2013 felony Attempted robbery and murders served time at the DOC and was released on Parole and put on probation in 2017, 2011 dealing marijuana, conversion unknown owes \$200,2008 felony robbery conversion unknown owes \$424, 2008 possession of marijuana, conversion unknown owes \$364.

B. Provisional

Gamino Rodriguez, Donovan (provisional upgrade) – **PROBATION** – current provisional license is on probation for unlicensed practice, has not petitioned to come off.

Rodriguez Marrero, Jean – **DENIED** – Puerto Rico issues a license, and lacking hours in 4 of the required courses.

Haney, Jovan – **DENIED** – Does not hold an active Indiana Primary license.

FACILITY APPLICATIONS

A. Beauty Culture Salon

Abbie Jewel Nail & Beauty Salon – **DENIED** – Owner falsified application and answered questions 1 and 2 incorrectly, she has been previously denied and esthetics license, she also had a complaint filed against her in 2007, she did not pay her fines until we delayed the renewal of her manicurist license in 2014.

Expert nails – **DENIED** –Owner falsified application and answered questions 1, and did not disclose that he had previously owned a BCS, pretty nails. His personal license is on probation and he had board action taken on it indefinite probation.

Wash & Glow, llc dba the Glow bar – **DENIED** –failed inspection had an unlicensed employee working, indicated they were only there to assist staff.

Soho Nails Spa llc – **DENIED** – failed inspection, providing waxing services in a room that does not meet the esthetics requirements, had a unlicensed employee on site, wasn't providing services when there but another employee stated he did manicures and pedicures. Also had multiple sanitation violations.

Certified Fadez Barbershop llc – **PROBATION** – Owner Narciso Soto personal license in on probation.

Lucky Nails – **DENIED** – Moved locations no TP issued as previous location was on probation, failed inspection, unlicensed employees, and unlicensed employees working, no covered receptacle, reusing disposal implements, no lancet safety device, esthetics room wall violation, unsterilized instrument use, Improper sterilization of implements.

Ivy Nails, Kha Nguyen owner – **PROBATION** – new owner, location was on probation previously

Crown Nail Lounge – **DENIED** – Failed inspection, unlicensed employees, unlicensed employees working, facility license not displayed, not wet disinfectant, license not displayed, unsanitary.

NEW BUSINESS

Greg Kenny requested to discuss a matter that would require an Executive Order by the Governor. Since the Board had no authority to take any action, there was no discussion.

It was the consensus of the Board to request IPLA file a complaint against Prestige Beauty School, SC41700001 for teaching outside the scope of esthetics and against Recalibrated Christian Beauty & Barber College, SC41800001 for allowing more than the required hours in manicurist discretionary subjects.
