A domain name is part of a URL (Uniform Resource Locator) is the address of a World Wide Web page. Security Certificate Included.

Examples:

- AllenCounty.IN.gov
- TownofRomeCity.IN.gov
- CityofElkhart.IN.gov

Why an IN.gov domain?

- Free SSL certificate
- Security and brand recognition of the IN.gov Program
- Grant money - easier to apply for with an IN.gov domain
- Can be used with MX records for IN.gov email address

HEA 1169



- Requires local governments to report cybersecurity incidents
- Objective - gain accurate information on the threats to local government information and operations
- Easy sign-up, easy reporting – cooperation has been terrific, looking for more sign-ups

Cybersecurity Risk Assessments



- FREE Cybersecurity Risk Assessments
- Partnership with Purdue University and Indiana University
- Sign up on our local government services site
- Answer a questionnaire with your team, meet with PU/IU officials to receive recommendations

SLCGP (Federal Program)



- State is receiving \$20M over the next 4 years to help local governments with their cybersecurity needs
- Created the SLCGP Planning Committee with local government officials and IT Directors
- Submitted our State Plan in April and just received approval
- Working on finalizing our projects (services) offered to local governments for free or reduced cost
