The 650 machine, paper ballot counter did not work Election night. It took us quite a while to get technicians here. We had 4 technicians show up and after they all had worked on the machine, we were finally able to count the paper ballots. The count was not delivered to the public until after 1 A.M. in the morning. The technicians recommended that ES&S send a repair man to work on the machine as they were unable to permanently fix the problem. Our representatives from ES&S have put a pad on it that the technicians thought was bad and we used it Friday to count our provisionals.
