The 2024 Indiana legislative session brought some exciting updates and additions to the Indiana Education Scholarship Account! Here are just a few of the essential supports in place for ESA students and families.

## New Updates!

- Co-pays, coinsurance, and deductibles
- Siblings in same household are now eligible
- Curriculum like books and digital content
- Supplementary materials like art supplies, etc.
- Transportation

## Tuition and Fees for:

- Participating schools
- Assessments and examinations
- Individual classes
- Extracurriculars
- Vocational programs
- Educational camps
- Skills programs
- Behavioral support programs

## Therapies and Services:

- ABA therapy
- Speech and language pathology
- Occupational therapy
- Physical therapy
- Art and music therapy
- Equine therapy
- Tutoring services
- Paraprofessional services

## ESA funds are applicable if:

- An expense is included in the student's special education services plan (IEP, SP, Choice, SP, or ESA SP).
- A physician has provided a prescription to the Scholarship Accounts Division office.
