

How to Read the Driver Record Summary

To access the summary, log into your myBMV.com account and navigate to the “Driver Records” tab.



This is the driver record summary.

The driver record summary provides a quick way to access several key bits of information regarding the current status of your license. First, license type indicates what type of credential you are currently holding. The License status field specifies whether the current credential is Valid or Suspended. If a credential is expired, it is **NOT** reflected here.

License type: DRIVERS
License status: VALID

The “SR22” field reflects any three- or five-year requirements for SR22 insurance. SR22 to stay and close suspensions for insurance violations are only reflected here AFTER the SR22 has been received. Once received, the date that the SR22 must be held through will populate here.

SR22: Not needed

The “Current points” field indicates how many points are currently accrued on the license. Points stay active for two years from the conviction date of the citation. Once 20 points are received on the license, an automatic one-month suspension will be assessed. Every two points over 20 will result in another month being added to the suspension. A BMV approved driver safety program may be completed one time every three years for a four-point credit, but if a points suspension has already been assessed it will not be removed.

The “Endorsements” field should reflect any endorsements which have been added to your license. A list of restrictions and endorsements can be found [here](#).

Endorsements: None

The “Pending Endorsements” field shows any endorsements that are expected to be on the next license issued. If you’ve completed an RSI approved motorcycle safety course, and are adding the motorcycle endorsement online, you will see it here.

Pending Endorsements: None

The “Restrictions” field shows any restrictions on your driving privileges such as glasses or daylight driving only. The “Pending Restrictions” shows any restrictions which will be present on the next license issued.
