### HUNTINGTON AMMONIA TERMINAL RECERTIFIED FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH PROGRAMS

**INDIANAPOLIS** (March 11, 2016) – CF Industries Sales, LLC, Huntington Ammonia Terminal, of Huntington, Indiana, achieved recertification in the Indiana Voluntary Protection Program (VPP) as a “Star” worksite.

“The facility and the hardworking staff running it continue to prove the benefits of a safe and healthy workplace,” said Indiana Department of Labor (IDOL) Commissioner Rick J. Ruble. “With no worker injuries in the last four years and their continued success, the IDOL is very proud to recertify the Huntington terminal of CF Industries.”

Huntington Ammonia Terminal, of CF Industries Sales, LLC, is an anhydrous ammonia refrigeration, storage, and distribution facility run by eleven employees. Indiana’s VPP evaluation team reviews all technical safety and health programs developed and implemented at potential certified worksites. CF Industries’s Huntington facility had a variety of developed programs and policies that met or exceeded OSHA standards and requirements, including all employee participation in safety meetings, comprehensive safety and health surveys, regular self-inspections, employee hazard reports, accident investigations, and hazard correction training.

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), the industry average Total Case Incidence Rate (TCIR) was 2.9 and the Days Away/Restricted/Transferred Case Incidence (DART) rate was 1.8. Huntington Ammonia Terminal, of CF Industries, Inc., falls well below that average thanks to having zero recordable cases and zero lost work day cases for the past 44 years.
