INDIANA GRAIN INDEMNITY BOARD OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Ted A. McKinney called this meeting of the Indiana Grain Indemnity Corporation Board of Directors to order at 2:30 p.m. (EDT) on July 22, 2014. The meeting was held in Conference Room 110 on the first floor of Teachers Credit Union building located at One North Capitol, Indianapolis, Indiana.

QUORUM: Chairman McKinney did a roll call of the Board members and confirmed that there was a quorum present. Chairman McKinney stated that to meet statutory requirements, this is the first meeting scheduled for year.

MINUTES: Copies of the minutes of the previous meeting (December 05, 2013) were forwarded to board members to review. G. Whaley moved to approve the minutes as written. (Second from R. Kron) *The motion was carried and the minutes of the December 05, 2013 meeting were approved as written.*

FINANCIAL: Financial statements and investment listings had previously been distributed to the board. Chairman McKinney asked the board to review and any questions to be directed to V. Pool, representative for the Office of the Treasurer of State. The Board had no questions for V. Pool. Balance of the fund as of June 30, 2014 was \$14,048,757.56.

NEW BUSINESS: Chairman McKinney referred to Interim Director Hudson Badskey about the state of the Agency. He reported to the board that there are still a few concerning licensees but the Agency is in a good working relationship with these firms to correct the issues. He then reported that they hired three new staff members:

Danae Wise of Bargersville IN, Licensing Officer Mark Scheumann of Fort Wayne, IN, Auditor Jacob Frazier of Bargersville, IN, Auditor

Interim Director Badskey reminded the Board that the Agency is scheduled to host the 2015 Annual Conference for the Association of Grain Regulatory Officials.

Chairman McKinney asked Interim Director Badskey to discuss the legislative proposals in the folders distributed to the Board Members. The Board approved the legislative updates and amended the requirement for minimum net worth from \$50,000 to \$100,000. The board agreed that minimum net worth increase needs to be phased in over a three to five year period.

There was much discussion on the indemnity fund. Chairman McKinney suggested a subgroup to meet and discuss changes to the fund to be held on August 20, 2014.

OLD BUSINESS: Chairman McKinney referred to Interim Director Badskey about the Mentone Trial. He gave his recollection of the trial to the Board and then referred to Heather Crockett. She then went into further detail about how the Attorney General's Office will proceed.

The Board discussed the possibility of forcing a sale on the land owned by Dutchland & Lambright to recoup funds from the 2009 failure. After discussion, J. Kessie motioned that there be a forced sale of the land. (Second by G. Whaley). A motion was made by J. Kessie to have an appraisal of the land before the sale and was seconded by M. Silver.

Interim Director Badskey gave an overview of the New Energy situation to the Board.

ADJOURNMENT: It was motioned that the meeting adjourn by R. Kron. (Second by B. Bischoff) The meeting adjourned at 4:35 p.m.
