PETITION FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The State of Indiana ("Petitioner"), by Deputy Attorney General Paul J. Schilling, moves the Indiana State Board of Nursing ("Board") to suspend the license of Brooke Hudson, R.N., ("Respondent"), for ninety (90) days, and in support of its Petition states the following:

1. Respondent is a Registered Nurse ("RN") in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 281974786A on June 21, 2011.
2. Respondent also holds Indiana Cosmetology license number BC20300255.
3. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 7587 Shadyside Drive, Bloomington, Indiana, 47401.
4. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with the provisions of Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-4 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10.
5. On or about July 13, 2015, Respondent was referred to ISNAP by her former employer, IU-Bedford, for errors in wasting controlled substances. Respondent was given a UDS which returned positive for Norco.
6. Respondent did not have an active prescription for Norco.
7. On or around September 8, 2015, Respondent returned her RMA to ISNAP.
8. On May 10, 2016, ISNAP extended Respondent's RMA for six (6) months because Respondent had a positive breathalyzer (.129) test at work on April 29, 2016.
9. Respondent had positive UDS screens on the following dates:

- a. May 2, 2016;
- b. May 4, 2016;
- c. June 10, 2016;
- d. June 17, 2016.

10. On June 29, 2016, ISNAP extended Respondent's RMA six (6) additional months due to the pattern of positive UDS screens.

11. On or about August 8, 2016, Respondent tested positive for alcohol. ISNAP extended her RMA for an additional six (6) months and referred Respondent for a re-assessment.

12. On January 26, 2017, ISNAP extended Respondent's RMA for an additional six (6) months because Respondent was non-compliant for the fourth quarter of 2016 and had a positive UDS on November 1, 2016.

13. On March 12, 2018, Respondent was found non-compliant for the fourth quarter of 2017 and had a positive UDS on February 5, 2018.


14. On March 23, 2018, ISNAP discharged Respondent for non-compliance.

15. Due to the above facts, the Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of Indiana.

**WHEREFORE**, Petitioner requests that this Board set a hearing on this petition for summary suspension and suspend the Respondent's license for a period of ninety (90) days and for all other proper relief.
