

6. The parties will resolve this matter via a Proposed Settlement Agreement (“PSA”), but the parties intend to file the PSA much closer to the date of the final hearing to allow Respondent additional time to comply with an ISNAP Recovery Monitoring Agreement.
7. For these reasons, it would be a better use of resources to vacate the intervening dates currently scheduled (November 6 and December 4, 2024) but maintain the final hearing date on December 12, 2024.
8. Undersigned counsel has discussed the filing of this Motion with Respondent, and Respondent is in support of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board vacate the CMO deadlines scheduled for November 6 and December 4, 2024, but maintain the final hearing date of December 12, 2024, and for all other relief just and proper in the premises.
