NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT

A pre-hearing/ settlement conference ("PHSC") was scheduled to be held on August 4, 2016, before an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") designated by the Indiana State Board of Nursing ("Board"), pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-9 in the Conference Room 4 of the Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, regarding the Complaint file against the Indiana nursing license of Samantha A. Jones, R.N. ("Respondent").

The State of Indiana ("Petitioner") was represented by Drake T. Land, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The ALJ, after taking official notice of its file in the matter and pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, issued a Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:
