VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT TO PETITION  
FOR EXTENSION OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The Petitioner, the State of Indiana, by Hilary L. Brown, Deputy Attorney General, ("Petitioner"), and Emily Mejia R.N. ("Respondent"), hereby execute this Agreement to summarily suspend Respondent's nursing license for an additional ninety (90) days. This Agreement is subject to the review and approval of the Indiana State Board of Nursing ("Board") and the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3 *et seq.* In the event that the Agreement is not approved by the Board, this Agreement shall be null and void and, in accordance with Indiana Rule of Evidence 408, may not be introduced into evidence in any civil, criminal or administrative proceeding. In support of its petition, Petitioner states the following:

STIPULATED FINDING OF FACTS

1. Respondent is a Registered Nurse ("RN") in the State of Indiana, having been granted RN License Number 28163239A on or about March 7, 2005, by the Board, and which expired on October 31, 2019.
2. Respondent's address on file with the Board is 19416 Paxson Place, Noblesville, Indiana 46060.
3. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent's license in accordance with Ind. Code 4-21.5-4 *et seq.* and Ind. Code 25-1-9-10.

4. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations contained in the Petition for Extension of Summary Suspension. However, Respondent recognizes the serious nature of the allegations and wishes to agree to the temporary, non-final suspension of her license for ninety (90) days.

#### STIPULATED CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The agreement of the parties as stated above establishes a sufficient factual and legal basis for the suspension of the Respondent's license pursuant to Ind. Code 25-1-9-10.

WHEREAS, this matter is set for hearing before the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Respondent and Petitioner wish to resolve this matter prior to a hearing and have reached a resolution.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE AGREED by Respondent and Petitioner as follows:

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Board has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the subject matter in this action commenced on or about May, 2019.

2. The parties execute this Agreement voluntarily.

3. Respondent and Petitioner voluntarily waive their rights to a public hearing on the Petition at this time.

4. Respondent has carefully read and examined this Agreement and fully understands its terms.

5. Respondent's license shall be **SUMMARILY SUSPENDED** for ninety (90) days from the July 16, 2020, meeting of the board as described in the terms above.

6. The parties agree to the continuing jurisdiction of the Board.

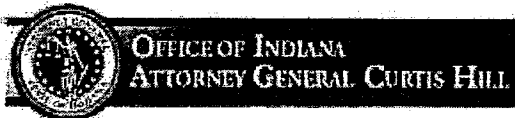
