**NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT**

An administrative hearing was scheduled to be held on August 17, 2006 before the Indiana State Board of Nursing ("Board") in the Auditorium of the Conference Center in the Indiana State Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46204, to consider the administrative complaint filed by the Petitioner on or about February 6, 2006 against Dennis Ray Miller, L.P.N. ("Respondent").

The State of Indiana was represented by Steven P. Douglas, Deputy Attorney General. The Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

The Board, after taking official notice of its file in the matter, pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, by a vote of 5-0-0, issues a Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:

1. The Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 273 Washington Avenue, #1, Evansville, Indiana, 47713. The Respondent also has a listed address of 1907 Jeanette Avenue, Evansville, Indiana, 47714. The

Respondent is a duly licensed practical nurse in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 27041641A.

2. A hearing notice was sent to the Respondent on or about April 17, 2006 for the original hearing in this matter which was scheduled for May 18, 2006. The Respondent asked for and received a continuance to prepare his defense. The matter was reset for a hearing to be held on August 17, 2006.

3. On or about July 6, 2006, the Board sent notice to the Respondent at his last reported address informing him of the time and date of the final hearing set in this matter.

4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the disciplinary hearing and failed to appear for the scheduled hearing on August 17, 2006 or ask for a continuance.

### **ORDER**

For the Respondent's failure to appear for the scheduled hearing, the Board issued the following **Notice of Proposed Default**:

In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If the Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against the Respondent, the Board

may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of the Respondent.
