SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

The Indiana State Board of Nursing (“Board”), pursuant to the authority of Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-1 and Ind. Code § 25-1-9-10, by a vote of 6 - 0 - 0, at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 20, 2020, in Conference Room B of the Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana., **SUMMARILY SUSPENDS** the nursing license held by Nakia A. Murrell, L.P.N. (“Respondent”), for ninety (90) days, as the Board finds that an emergency exists and that Respondent represents a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if allowed to continue to practice as a nurse in the State of Indiana.

The State of Indiana was represented by Patricia Gibson, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent appeared in person and waived her right to counsel.

This **NON-FINAL** emergency order is based on evidence supporting the following findings:

1. This Board has jurisdiction to suspend Respondent’s license in accordance with the
2. Respondent is a Licensed Practical Nurse (“LPN”) in the State of Indiana having been issued license number 27066285A on January 10, 2011.

3. Respondent's address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 2247 Windsong Drive, Apt. D, Indianapolis, Indiana 46229.

4. On her 2018 application for licensure renewal Respondent disclosed that in September, 2018, she was charged with Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated.

5. On January 4, 2019, the Board renewed Respondent's license on indefinite probation and required Respondent to complete any recovery monitoring agreement ("RMA") recommended by the Indiana State Nurses Assistance Program ("ISNAP").

6. On or about November 28, 2018, Respondent entered into a three year RMA, having been diagnosed with alcohol use disorder, moderate.

7. Respondent tested positive for alcohol on April 17, 2019, August 7, 2019, and November 4, 2019, and was given a six month extension of her RMA. Respondent also failed to submit meeting logs and therapist reports.

8. On January 6, 2020, Respondent tested positive for alcohol and cocaine metabolites. ISNAP increased Respondent's urine drug screens to twenty-six (26) per year.

WHEREFORE, RESPONDENT IS ORDERED to immediately cease and desist all acts constituting the practice of Nursing for ninety (90) days.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall immediately surrender all indicia of licensure, including her pocket license and wall license, to the Board in care of Indiana Professional Licensing Agency, 402 West Washington Street, Room W072, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.
