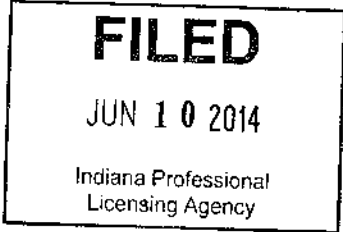

NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT

An administrative hearing was scheduled to be held on February 20, 2014, in the Auditorium of the Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, concerning the State of Indiana’s Complaint filed against the license of Corinna Niccum, R.N. (“Respondent”).

The State of Indiana was represented by Mark Mader, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Indiana State Board of Nursing (“Board”) issues this Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:

1. The Respondent’s address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency is 1909 Elmwood Avenue, Lafayette, Indiana 47909. Respondent is a Registered Nurse (“R.N.”) in the State of Indiana holding license number 28161783A. Respondent’s license was issued on September 9, 2004, and expired on October 31, 2013.
2. On December 18, 2013, the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency sent a notice to Respondent at her listed address informing Respondent of the date, time and place of the final hearing on this matter.
3. A Final Hearing was set for February 20, 2014. Respondent failed to appear at the Final Hearing.

4. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the Final Hearing and failed to appear for said hearing.

ORDER

For Respondent's failure to appear for the scheduled Hearing, the Board issues this Notice of Proposed Default:

In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against Respondent, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of Respondent.
