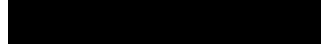

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MOTION FOR WITNESS TO APPEAR AND TESTIFY REMOTELY

Petitioner, the State of Indiana, by counsel, Deputy Attorney General Katy J. Kramer, files its “Motion for Witness to Appear and Testify Remotely” (“Motion”), to respectfully request the Indiana State Board of Nursing (“Board”) allow Petitioner’s witness, Kaylee Martin, to appear and testify via telephone or via videoconference at the July 17, 2025, administrative hearing. In support, Petitioner states the following:

1. On July 1, 2025, Petitioner filed its Petition for Summary Suspension (“Petition”) against the registered nurse and advanced practice registered nurse licenses of Morgan R. Oberle, R.N., A.P.R.N. (“Respondent”).
2. The Board’s next scheduled meeting is July 17, 2025. In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-4-4, the Board shall consider the Petition at this meeting.
3. Ms. Martin is an essential witness in this matter.
4. Ms. Martin is the individual that alerted her employer to Respondent’s improper disposal and potential diversion of a patient’s medication and the individual whom Respondent solicited for prescription medication for Respondent’s personal use.
5. Ms. Martin is a Medical Assistant at Lafayette Pain Care in Kokomo, Indiana and is scheduled to work on the day of the hearing. Due to Ms. Martin’s employment obligations and

her distance from Indianapolis, requiring the witness to travel there and back from her location and during work hours places an undue burden on her ability to testify.

6. The witness's testimony can be taken effectively in a remote setting—either via telephone or via videoconference.


7. Given the witness's essential nature to this hearing, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board allow Ms. Martin the opportunity to appear and testify via telephone or videoconference at the administrative hearing on July 17, 2025.
