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**NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT**

A Final Hearing was scheduled to be held on September 18, 2025, in Conference Room C of the Indiana Government Center South located at 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to address the issues raised in the Administrative Complaint filed by the State on April 3, 2025, against Lori Pribble-Williams, R.N. (“Respondent”).

The State of Indiana was represented by Amanda Elizondo Cassidy, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, by a vote of 9-0-0, the Indiana State Board of Nursing (“Board”) issues this Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:

1. Respondent’s email address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (“IPLA”) is loripribble@gmail.com.
2. On June 30, 2025, the Board sent a Hearing Notice and Case Management Order to Respondent at her email address on file with the Board informing Respondent that a final hearing would be held in this matter on September 18, 2025 at 8:30 am in Conference Room B of the Indiana Government Center South located at 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

3. On June 30, 2025, July 8, 2025, and July 10, 2025, Respondent engaged in correspondence with Petitioner, including discussion of the upcoming hearing on September 18, 2025, using the same email address on file with the Board.

4. On or about August 11, 2025, the Board issued an Amended Hearing Notice and Case Management Order to Respondent for the final hearing scheduled for September 18, 2025, updating some discovery deadlines, and moving the final hearing to Conference Room C, instead of Conference Room B. Other than the change in Conference Room, the date, time, and location of the hearing were the same listed in the June 30, 2025 Hearing Notice and Case Management Order. The Amended Hearing Notice and Case Management Order was served on Respondent's email address on file with the Board.

5. On September 18, 2025, Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel for the administrative hearing.

6. Pursuant to Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the final hearing and failed to appear for said hearing.

### **ORDER**

For Respondent's failure to appear for the Final Hearing, the Board issues the following Notice of Proposed Default:

In accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24, Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against Respondent,

the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of Respondent.
