**MOTION FOR ORDER COMPELLING
ADDICTIONOLOGY EXAMINATION OF THE RESPONDENT**

The State of Indiana, by counsel, Denise L. Quarles, Deputy Attorney General, respectfully moves the Indiana State Board of Nursing ("Board"), for an order compelling Sheryl Craig, R.N., ("Respondent") to submit to an addictionology examination as her capacity to practice nursing safely is at issue in this disciplinary proceeding. In support of its motion, the State will show:

1. The Complaint in this matter charges the Respondent with continuing to practice although unfit to practice due to addiction to, abuse of, or severe dependency upon alcohol or other drugs that endanger the public by impairing a practitioner's ability to practice safely pursuant to Ind. Code 25-1-9-4(a)(4)(D).

2. The Board may order a practitioner to submit to a reasonable physical or mental examination if her physical or mental capacity to practice safely is at issue in a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to Ind. Code 25-1-9-7.

3. Due to the nature of the charges, the Respondent should be ordered to submit to a complete addictionology examination by a board certified addictionologist whose written report concerning the Respondent's diagnosis, treatment, and prognosis should be filed directly with the Board.

WHEREFORE, the State of Indiana respectfully requests that the Respondent be ordered to provide the name and addresses of three (3) board certified addictionologists directly to the Board within seven (7) days of receipt of the Board's Order, from which the Board will select one (1). This addictionologist shall perform the examination at the Respondent's expense and submit a detailed, written report directly to the Board and to Denise L. Quarles, Deputy Attorney General, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the Board's order selecting the addictionologist.
