# Important Facts about the Indiana Arts Commission


- According to recent national economic development data, **50,000 Hoosiers are employed full-time in arts-related jobs**; roughly equal to twice the combined Indiana employment by Delphi, Eli Lilly, Toyota, and U.S. Steel generating local and state tax revenue.
- More than **420 grants are awarded annually** by the Indiana Arts Commission to not-for-profit arts and services organizations, and individual artists **in all 92 counties of the state** having a direct impact on employment, tourism, the purchase of goods and services, and generation of local and state tax revenue.
- **In FY 2009, Indiana Arts Commission funded projects, artists and organizations attracted over 26 million visits**, primarily by Hoosiers but also by out of state tourists – roughly twice the state population – and one funded organization, the Indianapolis Museum of Art, reports annual attendance greater than that of all Colts home games combined!
- **Nearly 85% of the Indiana Arts Commission annual budget is directed into grants** to not-for-profit arts and cultural service providers either directly from the IAC or its decentralized network of 12 Regional Arts Partner organizations.
- **Indiana Arts Commission grants support** individual artist development, summer concert series, community art fairs and festivals, artist in classroom projects, and touring artist performances, all of which have impact on state and local **economic development, business attraction, job creation, employee retention, educational excellence, cultural tourism, and quality of life.**
- **Indiana Arts Commission grants** in most cases require a minimum dollar for dollar match and **encourage local private sector investment** in the funded project.
- Foundations, corporations and individuals look at **Indiana Arts Commission funding as an indicator of excellence, quality, good management, and program effectiveness.**
- Access to federal, and often local tax support is determined after the commitment of State funding.
- All Indiana Arts Commission funding requires grant recipients **provide educational services** and **reach underserved populations**, including rural and ethnically and racially diverse populations.
- **Indiana Arts Commission funded projects encourage the development of volunteerism** through the efforts of thousands of citizen boards, trustees, committees and event workers, underscoring the commitment of Indiana's citizens to the arts.
- **Indiana currently ranks 37th** nationally in per capita funding for the arts. **Proposed budget reductions would place it 48th out of 50 states.**
- Through the fiscally responsible stewardship of the Indiana Arts Commission, **Indiana's modest investment** in cultural programs and services **is returned exponentially** to its citizens.

## Indiana Arts Commission FY2009 Granting Programs\*




