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Indiana Deferred Compensation Committee Meetings Now Livestreamed

INDIANAPOLIS – In a continuing effort to increase government transparency, the Indiana Deferred Compensation Committee (IDCC) is pleased to announce that beginning tomorrow it will livestream all meetings on the Internet.

"In Indiana, we strive to constantly increase the accessibility of honest, accurate information about our State's finances and the opportunity for public participation," said State Auditor Suzanne Crouch. "In an age where technology is such a large part of how people access information, it makes sense to ensure that public meetings are available through the Internet."

The first livestreamed meeting will be held tomorrow, Thursday, Aug. 19, at 9 a.m. Generally, IDCC meetings are held quarterly on the third Thursday of the month at 9 a.m. unless otherwise noted.

The IDCC is a statutory committee that is charged with the management and oversight of funds for Hoosier S.T.A.R.T., the State's deferred compensation plan for State employees. Auditor Crouch is the Administrator of the Committee, which consists of five members who are appointed by the State Board of Finance, per Indiana Code 5-10-1.1-4.
