RESULTS TO DATE

- program well accepted/appreciated by participants - built on 22 years of pre-existing relationships
- more frequent reports of OD preventative injecting techniques
- no reports of adverse use – most use aversive
- Over 32,000 reached since 1996
- 5,123 peer reversals thru Feb 2014
