- ◆ The members aim to reduce opioid abuse and the number of overdose fatalities in Hamilton County by including:
 - **♦** Law enforcement
 - **♦** Fire/EMS
 - **♦** Treatment partnerships
 - Recovery partnerships



WHAT IS C.O.P.E...

- ◆ C.O.P.E. follows the Quick Response Team (QRT) diversion model where the QRT serves the community by providing a timely intervention.
- ◆ The QRT conducts a home visit with the patient within 72 hours of release from medical care.




WHAT IS GOAL OF THE PROGRAM


◆ The goal of the program is to get the overdose survivor into treatment, reduce barriers to treatment and follow up with treatment providers to monitor progress.




2019 PARTICIPANT DEMOGRAPHICS ...








2019 PARTICIPANT CITY OF RESIDENCE ...




2019 PROGRAM ACTIVITY DATA ...






Home Visit Outcome



2019 TOTAL PATIENT ENGAGEMENT INTO TREATMENT...




THE QRT TEAM MAKE UP IS...

- **♦** Fire/EMS Staff
- **♦** Law Enforcement



QRT PROCESS...

- Process of identifying patients that have overdosed and followup:
 - **♦** Patient Identification/Outreach
 - **♦** Tactical Form
 - **♦** Consent Form



ROLE OF PEER RECOVERY SPECIALIST DURING A HOME VISIT...

- **♦** The Peer Recovery Specialist:
 - ◆ Identifies the needs of the patient.
 - ◆ Provides recovery support and other community resources to the individual and their families.




ROLE OF FIRE/EMS DURING A HOME VISIT...

- **♦** The Fire/EMS Staff:
 - Identifies immediate medical needs of the patient.
 - Provides a quick medical assessment of the patient.
 - **♦** Answers medical questions.
 - May transport the patient to a treatment center.
 - May provide Narcan and Narcan training to the family.



ROLE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT DURING A HOME VISIT...

- **♦** The Law Enforcement Staff:
 - Provides safety and security during the visit..
 - Provides information about overdose law to the patient or family member.
 - May provide transport to a treatment center.

- **♦** Law enforcement care package
- Narcan boxes
- **♦** Community Education Program:
 - Opiates In Our Society


