

Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship

Application Procedures and Requirements

The Commission for Higher Education will begin accepting applications for the 2017-18 academic year on November 1, 2016. The application will close December 31, 2016.

Application Procedures

Please review the entire application before attempting to apply. Applications must be completed in one sitting and cannot be saved. The application will be available on November 1, 2016 and will close on December 31, 2016.

Nomination Form

Students must include a signed nomination form completed by a teacher whom they would like to serve as their mentor while pursuing a teaching license. In addition, a school administrator or guidance counselor must sign the form verifying the student meets the academic requirements of the scholarship.

Writing Prompt

Students will also need to respond to a writing prompt. The writing prompt is, “Why do you want to be a teacher?” Responses must be no more than 500 words.

Application Procedures

The Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship application will request the following information to be recorded accurately [based on the time of application](#):

- Personal Information including Social Security Number
- High School Grade Point Average (GPA)
- High School Class Rank
- ACT or SAT Examination Score(s)
- Extracurricular Information for activities completed during high school
- Employment History
- Individual Awards and Honors awarded during high school
- Nomination Form, signed by a teacher and school administrator
- Prepared Writing Prompt
