SUMMER COVID-19 SUPPORT GRANTS

- To help combat end of school year "learning slump" due to Covid-19, the ICHE had available grant funds of up to \$130,000.
 - Gave out 11 grants to colleges/university & community partners
 - Nearly \$96,000 spent
 - Served more than 1,500 students

 - Family Engagement Programming (21st Century Scholar Enrollment, Next Level Jobs Promotion)
 - Pre-College/Postsecondary Equity (Focused on Indiana's College Achievement Gap)
 - Gave out 13 grants to community partners/schools
- Nearly \$84,000 in awarded grants
