Training for SFST Instructor In-Service and DRE's is now set and ready for registration.

Our speaker for this year will be Director Joseph Jones of the Ohio Highway Patrol Crime Lab. Director Jones joined the Crime Laboratory in 2008 where he is responsible for Drug Toxicology. Director Jones holds a Master of Science from the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine in Philadelphia. Director Jones most recently presented at the Impaired Driving Conference, in Cincinnati, Ohio in August of 2015 and for the Michigan Prosecuting Attorney's Association in November 2015. The focus of his presentation will be: "Negative Toxicology Results" as well as other drug trends including, Methcathinone, Heroin, and BHO – Butane Honey Oil.

Chris Daniels from IPAC will also provide a presentation for legal updates on case law and the current legislative session. Dr. Shelia Arnold, with State Toxicology will also provide updates from her Department.

Registration will begin both days at 8:00am, with the training beginning promptly at 8:30am and ending at around 4:30 pm. DRE Instructors will meet at 8:30 am and we will discuss your roll in recertification the following day and DRE Curriculum Updates. **SFST Instructors will meet at 12:30 pm.** The 10/2015 release of SFST Standards is available and will be discussed.

Day Two: DRE Recertification Training. You must bring your rolling log for review. This is extremely important for your continued certification. We will be reviewing the IACP Standards for the DRE program, and discussing the future plans for the program. Those staying for the DRE training and traveling more than **50 miles** will be provided lodging between the two courses.


