Exempted Sources of Reimbursement

Indiana Code of Judicial Conduct Rule 3.14 and its commentary provide that a judge is not required to report reimbursements on the annual Statement of Economic Interests from certain organizations for necessary and reasonable expenses associated with the judge's participation in educational activities. Pursuant to Indiana Supreme Court Order No. 94S00-1004-MS-200, the Indiana Commission on Judicial Qualifications shall maintain a list of all organizations designated by the Court as exempted sources of reimbursement and shall make that list available to the public.
