The Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) will offer services to the child's family while the child is in out-of-home care, to facilitate the child's return home.

Exception: Services will not be offered to the child's family when a court rules that reasonable efforts to reunify the family are not required.

DCS will engage the Child and Family Team (CFT) to develop a Family Service Plan. The team will review the family's Safety Assessment, Strength and Needs Assessment and Risk Assessment to assist in identifying the family's needs and corresponding services.

PROCEDURE

The Family Case Manager (FCM) will:

- Utilize the CFT to facilitate the identified family reunification services and support services outlined in the Case Plan. See separate policies, <u>5.8 Developing a Case Plan</u>, <u>5.10 Family Services</u> and <u>5.7 Family Team Meetings</u>.
- 2. Monitor and document the family's progress and update the court.
- 3. Document in case notes any reasons why services were not offered or were halted prematurely.
