Chapter 8: Out-of-Home Services Effective Date: March 1, 2011

Section 37: Holding a Placement during a Version: 2 Temporary Absence

POLICY

When a child in out-of-home care enters a hospital or is a runaway, the Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) will continue to make foster care payments to the resource family for a maximum of five (5) days.

PROCEDURE

[REVISED] The Family Case Manager (FCM) will:

- 1. Engage the Child and Family Team (CFT) regarding the child's return to the same resource home at the end of the temporary abence;
- Engage the CFT to discuss any possible changes to the current placement and/or alternative permanency plan. See separate policy, <u>5.15 Concurrent Planning</u>;
 Encourage the resource parent to have frequent face-to-face contact with the child during the temporary absence; and

- 4. Ensure that the resource family nome will have all of the necessary resources and support systems in place when the child returns to the home (i.e. counseling services, medical equipment).
