Temporary Absence

**POLICY: NEW** 

When a child in out-of-home care enters a hospital or is a runaway, the Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) will continue to make foster care payments to the resource family for a maximum of five (5) days.

#### **PROCEDURE**

The Family Case Manager (FCM) will:

- 1. Engage the Child and Family Team (CF1), regarding to a child's return to the same resource home at the end of the temporary a sence;
- 2. Encourage the resource parent to have a que face-to-face contact with the child during the temporary absence; and
- 3. Ensure that the resource family how will have all of the necessary resources and support systems in place when the could return to the home (i.e. counseling services, medical equipment).
