Allocations

P. Surbey read the list of providers that were approved for allocations for fiscal year 2015/2016. Asante-\$15,000, Boys to Men \$30,000, Brightwood \$24,000, Camptown \$21,500, Child Advocates (undoing racism)\$43,000, Children's Bureau (Respite) \$260, 000, Coburn Place \$25, 000, Craine House \$15,000, Damar \$15,000, Dayspring \$20,000, Domestic Violence Network \$16,000, Emberwood \$10,000, Families First (DV Training) \$30,000, Families First (Parents Cafes) \$18,600, Friends of Noah \$30,000, Happy Hollow \$25,000, Hawthorn \$15,000, Indiana Youth Group (LGBT programming) \$30,000, Indiana Youth Group (Cultural Competency) \$10,000, Inner Beauty \$60,000, Jameson Camp \$7,500, Kids Dance Outreach \$30,000, Kids Voice \$25,000, LaPlaza \$20,000, Marion County Superior Ct \$93,000, MCCOY \$50,000, Mentoring with Magic \$27,000, New Direction \$12,500, Pathways International \$21,000, Peace Learning \$25,000, Reach for Youth (School Collaboration) \$49,000, Reach for Youth (teen court) \$21,000, Social Health Association \$20,000, Stop Over \$8,000, Use what you Got Ministries \$21,900, VOICE \$10,000, Young Mens, Inc \$30,000, DCS (Trauma Informed Care) \$40,000, DCS (Misc)\$18,000.

There were 4 allocations that are being tabled until additional meetings can be scheduled. The total money allocated including admin fees was \$1,379,225. The amount remaining to allocate is \$50,070.48. All together there were 70 requests from 49 providers.

July 6 at 2:00 pm there will be a mandatory meeting for all new providers at Children's Bureau to review the requirements and expectations. All allocations except for New Direction SAVE will be voted on to exclude J. Davis from voting on her own program. The motion was passed and carried. New Direction SAVE was voted on with the exception of Council Member J. Davis's vote. The motion was passed and carried.
