

RICHARD J RICE

Richard J Rice is the former President and CEO of Teachers Credit Union, headquartered in South Bend, Indiana, a \$2.6 billion financial institution and the largest credit union in Indiana. Mr. Rice was employed by Teachers Credit Union for more than 39 years, serving as President and CEO for 24 years, retiring in 2011.

Within the Credit Union movement, Mr. Rice has served as the Chairman of the Members Development Company and served on the CUNA Governmental Affairs Committee. In the South Bend community, he currently serves on the Beacon Ventures Board of Directors and serves as the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Holy Cross College, Notre Dame, Indiana.

Previously, Mr. Rice served as the Chair of Memorial Health Systems, the United Way campaign, CONNECT (the Coalition for Educational Success in St. Joseph County) and Junior Achievement of Michiana.

Mr. Rice was presented with the Distinguished Hoosier Award, by two Governors, Governor Frank O'Bannon in 2002 and Governor Mitch Daniels in 2002.

Mr. Rice has served as the Chair of the Department of Financial Institutions since January, 2007 and is a graduate of Indiana University.
