Change to read as follows. Add to read as follows. Delete and substitute as follows. Delete without substitution.

Bring forward the existing Indiana Residential Code amendment definitions with the exception of the following:

- Delete the definition in Item (1) **Accessory Structure**. and substitute with: For the purposes of this code and Appendix E; a detached structure, not more than three stories in height that is located on the same lot as, and accessory to, a one or two family dwelling.
- Change Item (7) "...and FDA-approved boiler water ~~additions~~ additives for steam boilers."
- Delete Item (9), "FAMILY".
- Delete Item (11), "FOAM PLASTIC INSULATION".
- Change Item (28) "... after ~~SKYLIGHT AND SLOPING GLAZING, UNIT~~ to read..."
- Delete Item (33), "UNUSUALLY TIGHT CONSTRUCTION"

Renumber amendments accordingly.

REASON

This proposal brings forward the amendments to Chapter 2 definitions from the 2005 InRC with the exception of a change in the wording of Item (1) to clean-up the language, Item (7) because the wrong word was used, the deletion of the Item (9) definition of family because the definition is not practical or legal, the deletion of Item (11) because the error in the code has been corrected in the 2009 IRC, a change to Item (28) to reference the correct location and Item (33) because the term "unusually tight construction" is not used in the 2009 IRC.

Fiscal Impact: There is no increase in cost to construction.
