PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services are a vital public service to the people and communities of Indiana; and
- WHEREAS, countless lives have been saved by quality early medical treatment from the men and women of the emergency medical services community; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Indiana strives to continually improve its emergency medical services to provide all Hoosiers the highest standards of emergency medical care; and
- WHEREAS, emergency medical services personnel, including emergency physicians, emergency nurses, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, firefighters, educators and administrators, have engaged in many hours of specialized training to improve their lifesaving skills; and
- WHEREAS, members of emergency medical services teams are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week to provide emergency medical care; and
- WHEREAS, it is important for Hoosiers to recognize the dedication and accomplishments of these highly trained professionals;
