**NON-FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL**


On May 12, 2017, the parties submitted the attached request to dismiss the above-captioned matter. The request states that Petitioner obtained a Construction Design Release (CDR) from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security for a roll-up fire door that Petitioner installed between its pizza shop and an adjacent space (project number 391890). The Petitioner provided a copy of the CDR to Respondent and the parties agreed that the CDR resolved the issue in this appeal.

**Accordingly, the Administrative Law Judge now enters this Non-Final Order of Dismissal.** The ultimate authority in this matter is the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission. Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-29(d) requires any party seeking to preserve an objection to this order for judicial review to file a written objection that

1. identifies the basis of the objection with reasonable particularity; and
2. is filed with the Commission within fifteen days (or any longer period set by statute) after this order is served.

In the absence of an objection from a party or notice from the Commission of its intent to review any issue related to this order, the Commission shall affirm this order in accordance with Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-29(c). **This order will be considered by the Commission on June 6, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. (EDT), in Conference Center Room B, Indiana Government Center South, 302 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, IN 46204.**
