- I. **Presentation – Mike Woida (IMPD) – Critical Infrastructure.** Risk assessment and preparedness overviews. Defined critical infrastructure according to National Infrastructure Protection Plan. Overview of risk assessment process. All hazards approach, whether man-made or natural. Information sharing is key to effective incident command.

Automated Critical Asset Management System (ACAMS) is a web-based application to assess critical infrastructure assets. Tiered level for security access. Pre-incident report capability. RAAD Report, CARVER Report, MSHARRPP +V important Reporting tools.

Later April, first part of May for MOU for ACAMS use in Indiana. ACAMS is a stand alone program; however, coordination is accomplished by utilizing the NRP framework and WebEOC during emergencies or disasters.

- II. **Presentation - Disaster Recovery – Mike Alley – Lighthouse Readiness Group.** National Archives and Records Administration a good source for records retention. Company survival survey emphasized.

Lighthouse services include disaster recovery planning, business continuity planning, and COOP/COG process. Lessons learned emphasized. Both presentations will be distributed to committee members via email.
