Emergency Medical Services Training Course Announcement

The Texas Engineering Extension Service (TEEX) and the Indiana Department of Homeland Security present:

PER 212 Operational Level Response to HazMat/WMD Incidents

Target Audience

This course is designed for all public safety personnel who may have a role in responding to WMD events. Public safety agencies including emergency management personnel, first response agencies (fire, law enforcement, emergency medical services, public health personnel, etc.) volunteer disaster agencies, public works, transportation officials, and other agencies will benefit from a thorough understanding of the performance level (operations).

Course Description

The **3-day course** focuses on the special challenges faced by emergency responders and first receivers in dealing with a Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) or terrorist incident. Upon course completion, participants will be able to respond to a chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear or explosive (CBRNE); terrorism or, hazardous materials (HazMat) incident using the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), and preclude the spread of a CBRNE hazard to the public and/or the environment. This course also provides the participant with the knowledge base and practical skills needed to successfully complete the testing and skills evaluation required in order to obtain hazardous materials operations level certification through the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (NPQS/ProBoard).

Prerequisite

WMD/Terrorism Awareness for Emergency Responders (Internet) (AWR-110) is required prior to enrolling for this course. WMD/Terrorism Awareness for Emergency Responders can be found here: <http://www.teexwmdcampus.com>
