



## Critical Incident Reporting Requirements for County EMA's to the State EOC

- Incidents involving Legislative, Executive and Judicial officials resulting in serious injury or death.
- Acts of violence (murder, rape, etc..) at any state or county facility involving the general public or employee. This does not include accidents or minor injuries.
- Actual or suspected acts of terrorism to include bombs or bomb threats.
- Weapons of Mass Destruction.
- Incidents involving “white powder.”
- Breach of security at any state or county facility.
- Elevator, amusement ride and outdoor stage equipment accidents.
- Transportation accidents which require the involvement of the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB).
- Severe weather involving tornado activity (confirmed touchdown with damage), ice and snow storms, blizzards, etc., or an event requiring the use of shelters or other state assistance.
- Earthquakes resulting in damage to property inside the State of Indiana.
- Hazardous material incident that may result in injury, death or require an evacuation.
- Any major utility disruption; electrical, potable water, telephone, gas or petroleum.
- A severe flooding or the breaking of a dam or levee.
- Sniper activity.
- Any catastrophic building failure involving a state or county facility.
