

Haunted House Safety

Haunted houses are common for celebrating fall festivities. They can be fun, but must be up to standards according to the State Fire Marshal. Following these guidelines when visiting a haunted house can guarantee a fun and safe experience for all.



Make sure the attraction has been inspected. There should be a sticker indicating inspection.

Enough lighting should be placed around doorways, walkways, and any figures in the attraction.



Locate all exits before entering; all exits should be clearly marked.

Legitimate haunted houses should have numerous fire extinguishers and smoke alarms on hand.



Do not run through the haunted house. Please follow any direction the operator of the attraction gives you.
