

Fire Officer Strategy and Tactics

Skill Test 1 (7.1.13) Given an appropriate scenario, properly complete an NFA Quick Access Preplan.

Scenario Specifics:

The building is a single story 100 X 150 single story structure made of concrete block. It has an internal fire detection system with an off site security contract. It does not have sprinklers nor standpipe systems. It is located at 1515 N Georgia St. Has no fire walls and has a large continuous manufacturing area. It has two small offices set outside the main manufacturing area. Composition tar and stone roofing. Floor construction is concrete slab. One exposure immediately to the north of existing building. General business occupancy is printing shop.

Office walls are made of 2 X 4 construction with drywall finish on manufacturing side. Office side covering is wood veneer paneling.

The building maintenance area and certain areas within the main shop contain various cleaning solvents, rags, and multiple stacks of both loose and bound papers. Nearest hydrant is on the corner of Georgia and Harris .5 block North. Available flow of hydrant is 750 GPM.
