Featured Speaker

Professor Bruce Hoffman, a tenured professor in the Security Studies Program at Georgetown University, has been studying terrorism and insurgency for more than thirty years. Mr. Hoffman previously held the Corporate Chair in Counterterrorism and Counterinsurgency at the RAND Corporation. Mr. Hoffman was the Scholar-in-Residence for Counterterrorism at the Central Intelligence Agency between 2004-2006.

Mr. Hoffman was previously an adviser on counterterrorism to the Office of National Security Affairs, Coalition Provisional Authority, Baghdad, Iraq in 2004 and an adviser on counterinsurgency to the Strategy, Plans and Analysis Office at Multi-National Forces-Iraq Headquarters, Baghdad from 2004-2005.

Mr. Hoffman was the founding Director of the Centre for the Study of Terrorism and Political Violence at the University of St. Andrews in Scotland.

Mr. Hoffman is Editor-in-Chief of *Studies in Conflict and Terrorism*, the leading scholarly journal in the field, and series editor of the new *Columbia Studies in Terrorism and Irregular Warfare* published by Columbia University Press.

Mr. Hoffman is the acclaimed author of *Inside Terrorism*.

▶ Important Information ◀

This training is *free* to all state, county, and local law enforcement agencies. **Two nights** lodging will be paid for state, county, or local law enforcement only (employees of the federal government or private corporations are not eligible). For lodging to be covered, the eligible attendees must live more than 50 miles from the conference location. Attendees staying more than two nights are responsible for the extra night's expense. Those who register and *do not* attend will be responsible for the registration fee and/or the lodging expense if not cancelled by the required deadlines. Mileage and per diem will not be covered and are the responsibility of the individual or agency.

Lodging will be at the **Sheraton Hotel, Keystone at the Crossing** in Indianapolis. Participants are responsible for making their own room arrangements.
