***This class will meet or exceed the State requirements for Rope Rescue Awareness & Operations and NFPA 1670- Standard on Operations & Training for Technical Rescue Incidents. This course is also a prerequisite for certification in Water Rescue Awareness and Operations for the State of Indiana.

Awareness – Basic initial company response. Responders at this level have the basic information to identify the type of incident and start initial company operations.

Operations – This is a basic technical response. Individuals at this level of training are able to deal with most non-complex situations, such as low-angle rescue, and provide support for technical rescue incidents.

Course Prerequisites:

Student must be certified from the State of Indiana minimum 1st Responder & Firefighter I/ II

What you will need for class:

- CMC Rope Rescue Manual (3rd Edition) Edited by James A. Frank (\$22.00)
- Comfortable clothing for working outdoors in the weather:
(Bunker gear, short or long sleeve shirt, sweatshirt, coveralls, BDU's, etc.)
- Fire Helmet or hardhat
- Utility, rope, or extrication gloves
- Eye protection
- Work Boots (Does not have to be steel toe)
