OVERVIEW

Think Map software has been designed specifically for local governments to manage, plan, and track all county related activities including land use, public safety, and infrastructure. We provide both data and an intuitive program to access and update that data. Think Map provides quick responses to basic and advanced information needs. Numerous cities and counties all over the country have already discovered the advantages and flexibility of Think Map.

Orange County (the "Client") wishes to upgrade their Digital Mapping System used for Public Safety to include pinpointed addresses for Orange County, including the incorporated areas of Paoli, West Baden Springs, French Lick, and Orleans. This contract defines the scope of products and services to be offered by WTH Engineering, Inc (the "Company") and the compensation to be paid by the Client.

PRODUCTION SERVICES

Field Inventory of Addresses

The Company will determine the location and identity of the addressed structures in Orange County and place all of these addresses onto a map layer that can be viewed with Think Map. One hundred percent success cannot be promised in work like this but in order to assure that as many structures as possible are identified, the following procedures will be used:

- 1) The Company will drive each street and mark the location of every structure that is visible from the road or is visible in the in-car aerial photography when only a driveway can be seen from the road.
- 2) The Company will record the house number with the structure whenever posted or record any auxiliary information, such as a name, that could be helpful later in determining the address.
- 3) When the field work is completed for an area, the Company will compare the addresses marked in the field to those listed in an address listing provided by the Client. This listing can be a 911 database, utility records, or any other source determined by the Client to be accurate. During this step, most of the houses not identified in the field can be determined by process of elimination.
- 4) During the field work stage (steps 1 and 2 above) structures with no posted house number will be left unidentified since most of these will be later identified in step 3. Knocking on the doors of all un-marked houses is NOT included in the scope of this work. The only exception to this is when multiple unidentified houses are clustered together such that their addressing order is not obvious. In these cases the Company will gather the required field information by knocking on doors.
- 5) The Company will combine the house numbers gathered in the field with road maps and the Client's MSAG to determine a complete address for each structure including house number, pre direction, street name, and community name.
- 6) Once completed, the Company will provide the Client with a report and a map listing any structures that could not be identified along with any recorded notes that may serve as hints as to their identity.

DELIVERY

Installation and Training

When the project is completed, WTH Engineering will install the software and data files onto each department's existing computers and setup each workstation with a strategy of sharing data with the other departments. The Company will provide on-site training for maintaining the address layer with emphasis on addressing for 911 and addressing consistency.
