REVISED CERTIFICATION OF LOCAL PUBLIC QUESTION

This revised certification of local public question replaces in its entirety the certification of local public question dated the 2nd day of March, 2010, which I hereby declare to be null and void.

Having examined and reviewed a Certificate of the Marion County Board of Voters Registration stating that the required number signatures have been affixed to a petition requesting a local public question, and having received the estimate of the relevant property tax rate from the Department of Local Government Finance, I do hereby certify, pursuant to Indiana Code 6-1.1-20-3.6(c) and (d), to the Marion County Election Board, the following public question to appear on the ballot for the May 4, 2010 primary election:

"Shall the Metropolitan School District of Pike Township, Marion County, Indiana, issue bonds or enter into a lease to finance the Tax Neutral New Guion Creek Elementary School Project in order to create equity among our elementary students in the 21st Century by providing our teachers with the tools needed to offer a quality education to all of the children in our community, which is estimated to cost not more than \$21,475,000 and is estimated to increase the property tax rate for debt service by \$0.2375 per \$100 of assessed value based on the assumption that the debt service fund tax rate would otherwise be \$0.00?"
