RE: 2008 & Prior Year Tax Delinquency Collections for School General Fund

DATE: October 7, 2009

On August 21, 2009, the Auditor of State sent a memorandum advising county auditors of a requirement to distribute 2008 and prior year delinquent property tax collections to certain school corporations if the school corporations experienced a property tax shortfall in their General Fund due to those delinquencies (IC 6-1.1-27-9).

The Department of Local Government Finance ("Department") has compiled the attached list of school corporations that have experienced a levy shortfall in the General Fund. Upon receipt of the funds, the school corporation is required to deposit the distribution in the school corporation's general fund.

The Auditor of State will follow up with accounting and distribution instructions for county auditors at a later date, depending on the status of the county's settlement.
