Whitley County Consolidated Schools, Whitley County, Indiana Information Regarding the November, 2015 Referendum

Item 1 The cost per square foot of any buildings being constructed as part of the controlled project.

The new High School is expected to total approximately 270,000 square feet. The construction and equipping cost is approximately \$259.42 per square foot. Including soft construction costs, the cost per square foot is approximately \$276.66/square foot.

Item 2 The effect that approval of the controlled project would have on the political subdivision's property tax rate.

The Project has been structured to increase the payments over time as the district's other obligations are retired and as existing tax abatements expire. The issuance of lease obligations to fund the project is expected to occur in late 2017. Initial payments requiring a tax rate of approximately 11.7 cents will occur in 2018 through 2020. After most of the district's other bonds mature in 2020, payments will increase in 2021 and require a tax rate of nearly 53 cents. The maximum property tax rate of 59.47 cents represents an increase of 8.3 cents over the expected 2017 property tax rate in the area of the Whitley County Consolidated Schools.

Item 3 The maximum term of the bonds or lease.

The First Mortgage Bonds are expected to be issued in late 2017 and will have a maximum term of 20 years. The lease will have a maximum term of 24 years. Property tax payments for the Project will be completed in 2037.

Item 4 The maximum principal amount of the bonds or the maximum lease rental for the lease.

A maximum of \$85,000,000 in First Mortgage Bonds will be issued. Following smaller payments, the maximum lease rental payment of \$7,550,000 will occur between 2023 and 2037.

Item 5 The estimated interest rates that will be paid and the total interest costs associated with the bonds or lease.

A 5.0% interest rate has been assumed for the project's financing and produces \$55,582,000 in total interest costs over the lifetime of the bond issue. If bonds were being issued currently, the average interest rate would be approximately 3.5% and the total interest would approximate \$39,170,000.

Item 6 The purpose of the bonds or lease.

The 2016 Safety, Security, Replacement and Restoration Project includes the construction of a new Columbia City High School and other related campus improvements and safety, security and efficiency improvements at the other school and community facilities used by WCCS students.
