This example notice is intended to be sent to the owner or operator of each well for oil and gas purposes identified under 312 IAC 29-7-3(1) and each property owner located within ¹/₄ mile of a proposed noncommercial gas well that does not conform to applicable spacing limitations set forth in 312 IAC 29-13-3 and 312 IAC 13-4.

EXAMPLE:

NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR A Noncommercial Gas Well Permit
