
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Reserved Hunt Information



Reserved Hunt Registration

Welcome to the Department of Natural Resources' online Reserved Hunt application. First, we must verify your current hunting license.

Licensed migratory bird hunters in Indiana must register with the national migratory bird Harvest Information Program (HIP), before they hunt coots, doves, ducks, mergansers, gallinules, geese, snipe, sora rails, or woodcock. Call 1-866-671-4499 toll-free or online at www.wildlife.IN.gov and provide the requested information. The registration is valid for the duration of the current migratory bird season. Lifetime license holders must also register with HIP. Hunters need only call once each season, not every time they hunt.

Please have you hunting licenses ready.

If you are applying for a State Park Deer Reduction hunt, please also have:

- License numbers and birth dates of the members of your party,
- Hunter Education and/or Bow Hunter Education certification numbers for the members of your party.


