

Registration for 2010
Reserved Turkey Hunts for the Youth Spring Turkey Season
On Fish and Wildlife Areas and Reservoirs

Reserved youth spring turkey hunts will be offered for Saturday, April 17 & Sunday, April 18, 2010 on selected state fish and wildlife areas and reservoirs. Each property will conduct two half-day hunts for eligible youth. The half-day hunts are ½ hour before sunrise to 1:00 pm in the eastern time zone and 12 noon in the central time zone. In order to provide a quality hunting experience, only a limited number of youth hunters will be allowed to hunt each day. A youth hunter may be drawn for one, or both hunt days, or may not be drawn at all, depending on the number of applications received.

Youth hunters, or an adult representing them, may register for the drawing **in person** at one of the fish and wildlife area or reservoir offices from March 15 to March 26, 2010, 9:00 am to 3:00 pm local time. Each youth hunter must have a youth consolidated hunting license (or lifetime license) and supply the license number in order to register. The drawing will be conducted on March 29, 2010 and all applicants will be notified of the drawing results by mail. There will be no stand-by drawings on the days of the hunts to fill unclaimed spots.

Properties participating include Atterbury, Crosley, Glendale, Goose Pond, Hovey Lake, Jasper-Pulaski, Sugar Ridge, Kankakee, Kingsbury, LaSalle, Pigeon River, Tri-County, Minnehaha, Fairbanks Landing, Hillenbrand, Chinook, Winamac and Willow Slough Fish and Wildlife Areas, as well as at Salamonie, Roush and Mississinewa lakes.
