Dunes Prairie Nature Preserve



Location and Access

Parking and trail. Located in the SW corner of Indiana Dunes State Park, on the west side of the entrance road. Trail 3 goes through the preserve.





Description:

This preserve contains a significant prairie remnant that has been monitored by botanists for decades. It also contains a tributary of Dunes Creek, as well as a black oak savanna, swamp forest, and graminoid dune. Periodic prescribed burns keep these natural communities in a healthy condition. This preserve contains outstanding prairie and wildflower displays.
