
## **Sebert Woods Nature Preserve**

County: LaPorte Size: 39.15 acres Ownership: LaPorte County Parks Foundation, INC.

## **Location and Access**

**Parking and trail.** From the east side of Michigan City, go north on SR 212 to CR 900 N (about 2.7 miles). Turn right (east). The road jogs left, then right just before the preserve, becoming CR 925 N. The preserve is just past the intersection of CR 375 W and CR 925 N, on the south side of the road. A 0.5 trail will guide you through the preserve.



**Description:** The property is a boreal forest relic and contains plants and habitat you would normally see much farther north. It is located directly south of Wintergreen Woods Nature Preserve.

This is a remnant northern boreal flatwoods natural community, which is a type of forest restricted to a narrow area just south of the Lake Michigan dunes.
