## FEATURING: A “Rolling” Battle Demonstration Between Russian and German army reenactors

Spectators should arrive by 9:45 AM and will be directed by Traffic Guides to the Lawrence Creek Trail Head parking area where they will be transported to battle viewing areas as it progresses and returned to their vehicles afterward.

**Late arrivals will be guided to the current battle viewing area  
and nearest parking area.**

- 10:00 AM –Rolling Battle begins near the Lawrence Creek Trail Head
- 10:30 AM – Spectators load onto hay wagon for transport to viewing area.
- 11:00 - Wagon arrives at battle viewing Overlook #2 as battle progresses to be viewed
- 1200 –Spectators load back on to transport and moved to next area for battle viewing.
- 12:30 – Spectators arrive at battle viewing Overlook #3
- 1:15-1:30 - Load for last segment of rolling battle demonstration
- 2:00 – Arrive and escorted to viewing bleachers for Overlook #4  
and finale of battle.

Approx. 1430 (2:30 PM) –Guests will be returned to their vehicles  
at the Lawrence Creek Trail Head parking area.

**The museum building and Eastern Front displays will be open from 10 AM to 6 PM.**

There is no charge for this event but regular State Park entrance fees apply.

Please note: The demonstration will take place in all weather,  
please dress accordingly for cold or rainy conditions.
